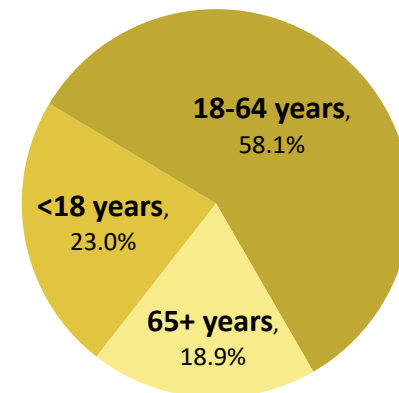
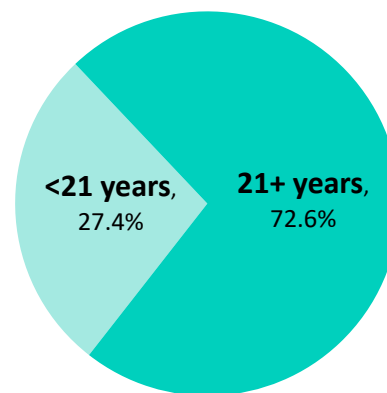
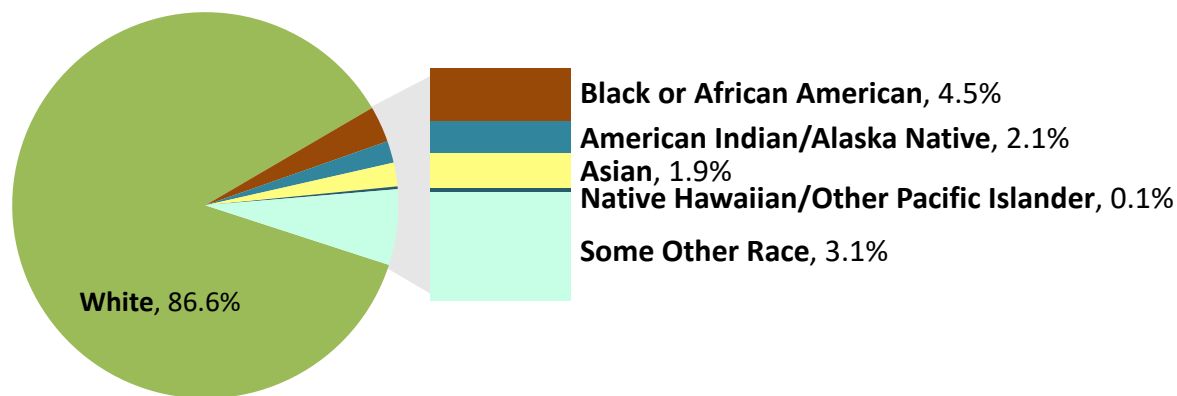


# Southwest Region

## Minnesota Prevention Region Demographic Report

Minnesota's Southwest Region includes 27 counties: Big Stone, Blue Earth, Brown, Chippewa, Cottonwood, Faribault, Jackson, Kandiyohi, Lac qui Parle, Le Sueur, Lincoln, Lyon, Martin, McLeod, Meeker, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Pipestone, Redwood, Renville, Rock, Sibley, Swift, Waseca, Watonwan, and Yellow Medicine Counties.

In 2020, the population was **517,067** people, **9.1%** of the state total.\*

The population in the SW Region increased by **0.7%**, or about 3,510 people, from 2010 to 2020\*

**7.2%** of those under 65 have no health insurance\*

**5.0%** of the Southwest population is foreign-born\*

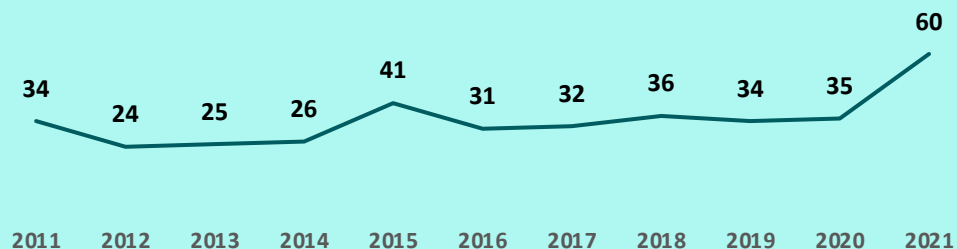
The poverty rate in the Southwest Region is **10.4%\***

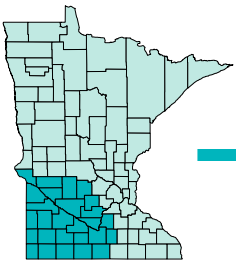
In 2020, **22%** of SW adults reported **excessive drinking**<sup>^</sup>

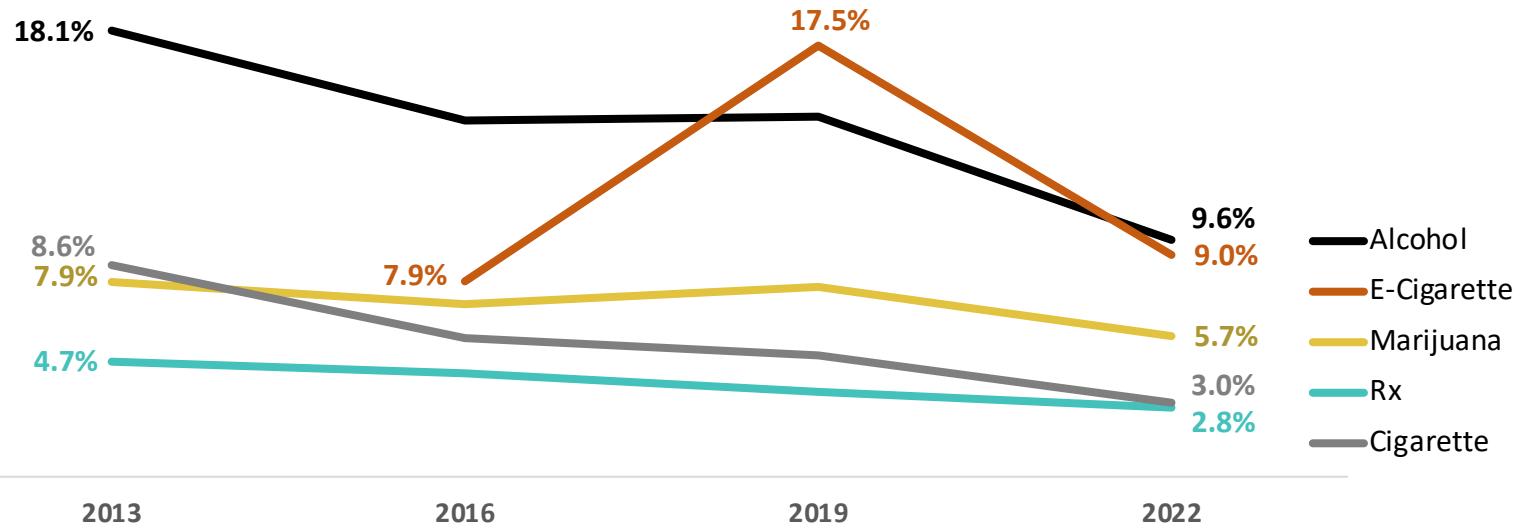
**30%** say they can talk to an adult at school about problems

**90%** said **NO** to **ALCOHOL**



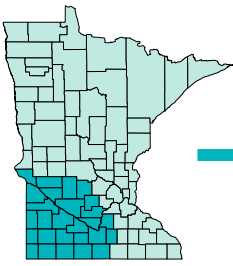

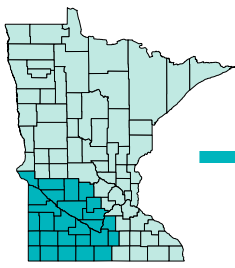

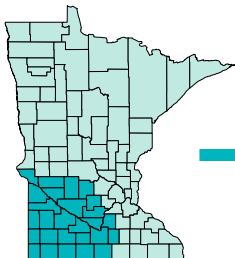

#### **SOURCE** ^ Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS)

**DATA** Substance use and other health data, state-level, with data from some cities: Minneapolis/St. Paul/Bloomington; St. Cloud; Fargo; Duluth; Rochester.

**DATA** The Census has a Quick Facts site that makes it easy to search for the latest data by city, county, state, or zip code. The data include population by various demographics, as well as other facts like education level, percentage of people with disabilities, and poverty rate.

#### **SOURCE** County Health Rankings (CHR)

**DATA** The County Health Rankings uses various data sources to compare health measures across states and counties. Because CHR compiles data from multiple years, they have data for counties where sample sizes would otherwise be too small to report, like BRFSS data. For substance use-related measures, CHR includes excessive drinking, alcohol-impaired driving deaths, drug overdose deaths, and adult smoking. Data can be searched by location or by topic.

**DATA** MDH has drug use profiles for each county, which are available on the website as dashboards, or as downloadable PDFs. Profiles cover opioids, prescription drug misuse, and overdoses. These profiles do not cover marijuana, alcohol, or tobacco.
